Required documents for enrollment at Undergraduate study programmes – full times learning - 2018

The required documents will be in a file and will contain the following:

- **Application form and the candidate's commitment;**
- **Bacalaureate diploma (original), an equivalent of the diploma or a graduation certificate for the Bacalaureate exam for the 2018 high school graduates** in which the final average is mentioned, the average of the study years, expiration date and the fact that the Bacalaureate diploma was not issued. In case the candidate is enrolled for admission at another university, he / she can bring a copy of the diploma together with the credential that is enrolled at the admission contest at the first university;
- **Transcript of records** – original and copy;
- **Health certificate**, issued by the medical school clinics or by the family doctor proof that the candidate is healthy. The candidates from **Physical education and sport, Kinesiotherapy, Health, Theatre and performing arts, Music** must have their health certificate stamped by the doctor from the Student Medical Department – Str. Parcului no. 4, student housing building F, first floor. For the candidates at the above mentioned programmes, the health certificate is mandatory to contain blood test. The Admission Committee has the right, by survey, to check the health certificates which state the candidates health and in exceptional cases to ask for a point of view from a doctor;
- **Three I.D. photographs;**
- **Receipt** of paying the enrollment fee at the admission test or the document proving that he / she is exempted from paying the fee. The enrollment fee is 150 RON for each faculty;
- **Birth certificate** – copy;
- **Marriage certificate** (if necessary) – copy;
- **Graduation diploma** – original - and **transcript of records** – copy – for short term university graduates who want to attend a related study programme or another study programme and enroll at the admission contest;
- **Engineer degree / Bachelor degree** – original – and **transcript of records** – copy – for university graduates (according to the Law 288/2004) and for long term university graduates (according to the Law 84/1995) who want to enroll at another faculty;
- **Student certificate** issued by the faculty's secretariat for candidates who want to attend simultaneously two study programmes / faculties. Students enrolled at a study programme

will request at the secretariat a copy after the Bacalaureate diploma and after the transcript of records both certified as “according to the original”.

All the copies required for the admission file will be certified “according to the original” by the designated person within the admission committee.

Candidates who enroll at Theology have to present a certificate of baptism and the written agreement of the archbishopric or of the bishopric they belong to. Moreover, candidates belonging to other eparchies must request the confirmation from the “Dunarea de Jos” Archbishopric.

Enrollment fee for the admission contest – 2018

The enrollment fee for the admission contest is 150 RON for each faculty and it must be paid when the file is submitted.

Admission candidates from 2018 whose parents are graduates of “Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati benefit from a 50 RON discount of the enrollment fee. They must present the parent’s graduation degree when enrolling.

Information regarding the health certificates from the Student Medical Department

The candidates from **Physical education and sport, Kinesiotherapy, Health, Theatre and performing arts, Music** must have their health certificate stamped by the doctor from the Student Medical Department – Str. Parcului no. 4, student housing building F, first floor:

- 09 – 14 July 2018, between 8.00 – 15.00
- 15 July 2018, between 8.00 – 12.00

For the candidates at the above mentioned programmes, the health certificate is mandatory to contain blood test.

In order for the health certificate to be approved by the Student Medical Department, the candidates must bring proof of vaccinations.

The Admission Committee has the right, by survey, to check the health certificates which state the candidates health and in exceptional cases to ask for a point of view from a doctor.
