Selection of Erasmus+ incoming students	<p>To benefit of a KA107 Erasmus+ mobility for studies, incoming students have to be selected by their home university within a selection process and procedure. In general, selection criteria for students are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the student must be registered and enrolled in studies leading to a recognised degree or another recognised tertiary level qualification (up to and including the level of doctorate);</li> <li>- the student must be enrolled at least in the second year of higher education studies, at the beginning of his/her Erasmus+ mobility;</li> <li>- the student must be enrolled in a study area/program that is similar to the study area/program offered by the host university;</li> <li>- to have a good academic performance during his/her previous academic year or semester (this second provision applies to the candidates who are in the first year of study);</li> <li>- to prove a good level of language (English or French) competence (at least B2).</li> </ul> <p><b>Important notes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- student-candidates have to apply and to be selected according to the mobility offer, available at <a href="http://www.en.ugal.ro/studies/ka107-icm-erasmus-programme/ka107-erasmus-student-mobility-for-studies/general-mobility-offer-and-financial-support-for-2020-2021">http://www.en.ugal.ro/studies/ka107-icm-erasmus-programme/ka107-erasmus-student-mobility-for-studies/general-mobility-offer-and-financial-support-for-2020-2021</a></li> <li>- as the mobility offer is per countries, both student-candidates and staff involved in the selection process are kindly asked to contact the KA107 Erasmus+ team to be sure that the mobility offer is still available for a certain university.</li> </ul>
Nomination and application for incoming Erasmus+ students	<p>Before applying, the selected students must be nominated by their home institution:</p> <p>The home institution should send a nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, study cycle, actual year of study, period of study, copy of passport) to the KA107 Erasmus+ team (<a href="mailto:luminita.iosif@ugal.ro">luminita.iosif@ugal.ro</a>, <a href="mailto:dan.scarpete@ugal.ro">dan.scarpete@ugal.ro</a>) prior to the nomination deadline.
